

MINUTES OF MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS

APRIL 18, 1970

Members present: Messrs. Caldwell, Forrest, Hayward, Voss, Heninger, Schurecht, Tucker and Wagner.

The meeting was called to order by Mr. Voss at 10:20 A.M. Saturday, April 18, 1970. Mr. Voss requested the individual municipalities that had passed or adopted the resolution of the Council of Governments of the Barrington area be recorded.

North Barrington reported yes. Deer Park were to have a meeting Monday night, April 20, 1970 and Tower Lakes were to have a meeting Monday night, April 20, 1970. Both municipalities, by their representatives, felt that they would have a favorable vote. South Barrington voted yes. Lake Barrington, no. Barrington Hills, yes. Barrington, yes. A lengthy discussion was then held on the comprehensive zoning map as presented by Mr. Nelson Forrest. Mr. Heninger responded that a land use map that would be suitable for an overlay program should be available no later than Wednesday, April 22, 1970. Mr. Tucker and Mr. Caldwell recommended that Mr. Voss write a letter to the Illinois Legislative Commission as well as to Constitutional Committees relative to the present cost of tax from land as a benefit to a tax <sup>LAND</sup> benefit for those lands or areas that were kept as open spaces. A lengthy discussion was held on this matter.

Mr. Nelson Forrest and Mr. Tom Hayward respectively were to contact Jan Millin, Delegate to the Constitutional Convention in our area relative to the aforementioned action taken by this committee.

OUR NEXT MEETING WILL BE HELD ON SATURDAY, APRIL 25, 1970 at 8:30 A.M. IN THE VILLAGE COUNCIL CHAMBERS IN THE VILLAGE OF BARRINGTON.

It has been requested by Mr. Cy Wagner that this committee should seriously consider the formulation of a soil conservation district and a soil conservancy district for the purpose of maintaining open spaces in the Barrington area. Mr. Tom Hayward at this time presented three points of activity that should be or could be employed in the future rezoning of the Barrington area. Discussion.

It was later pointed out by Mr. Wagner that the League of Womens' Voters will assist the Council of Governments in a massive meeting for the public which could be held on May 19, 1970 in the Barrington High School Auditorium.

Again, please be reminded that we will have a meeting on Saturday, April 25, 1970 at 8:30 A.M. in the Council Chambers. These are brief Minutes as the writer does not intend going into detail.
