## William Penn Fostered First German Settlement

It is said that when Port Royal, South Carolina, was settled by a band of Huguenots under Jean B. Bault in 1662, there were some Alsatian and Hessian Protestants who formed the company. This settlement was destroyed by the Spaniards in 1666.

There are also supposed to have been a few Germans, Swiss and Dutch in the Jamestown settlement, founded in 1607. From then on there are numerous references in colonial history to German immigrants and settlers. There were some in New Netherland, probably some in the Swedish settlements on the Delaware, and an occasional German in the Spanish and French colonies.

The first permanent German settlement in America was that fostered by William Penn at Germantown, founded in 1683. Francis Daniel Pastorius, a leader of the movement of German Protestants to America, took ship in advance of those he had induced to migrate, and landed at Philadelphia, August 20, 1683.

On October 6, 1683, the ship Concord, the Mayflower of the German immigrants to America, arrived in Philadelphia, and this date has customarily been observed by Germans in America as the beginning of their history in the United States.

What Became of German Fleet ... Under the terms of the Armistice the entire German fleet surrendered to the British navy at Scapa Flow in November, 1918, and was there interned. On June 21, 1919, the German crews scuttled the ships of the fleet with the exception of the cruiser "Baden."
