Report Material Gain in 10 Days' Sale of Buicks

Flint, Mich., June 14.—A substantial gain in retail deliveries of Buick automobiles in the last ten days of May over deliveries in the previous ten day period was reported today by W. F. Hufstader, general sales manager of the Buick Motor company.

Factory shipments during the ten day period were in excess of 4500, meeting a nationwide demand for deliveries of the new series 40 cars of which there was a pronounced shortage.

Retail deliveries of Buick cars to June 1 this year were 23,347 as compared with 20,991 in the corresponding 1933 period.
