A FINE UNDERTAKING

A government which has undertaken so much as has the Roosevelt administration is bound to reap a great deal of favorable as well as unfavorable criticism. None but the most biased partisan critics will find everything wrong and nothing right in the undertakings of the president and his official associates.

For generations it has been recognized in this country that conservation of natural resources is a duty of the national and state governments.

During the past 15 years, the great farming areas of the country have experienced drier than normal weather (with two or three years exception). The long dry spell has not been severe enough to seriously curtail crop production outside of two drought years; but steadily through the entire period, the lake, stream and subterranean water levels of the area have been receding.

Science warns that droughts will be more frequent and more severe until something has been done by man to stop them. Restoration of great forests and lake areas which act as moisture retainers and reservoirs has been advanced as the only method of conserving the great central portion of the United States for fertile farm land with abundant moisture.

With a view to minimizing the damage of future droughts, the government during the past week took the first step in a gigantic reforestation project. A forest "shelter belt" 100 miles wide and extending more than one thousand miles through the drought area from the Canadian border to Texas is to be undertaken at a total cost estimated at \$75,000,000. Ten years will be required to complete the project and an initial expenditure from PWA funds has been authorized in an executive order signed by President Roosevelt on July 11 and made public here this past week.

The theory is, and it has proved to be practical in Europe, that these strips of forest will break the velocity of the wind both in winter and summer, hold the soil in place, conserve the moisture in the soil and provide havens of shelter for man, beast and bird.
