Wurdum stands six feet and four inches, weighs close to 200 pounds, and has a good all-around game. Regardless of contributing causes, the great number of deaths from tuberculosis among girls should cause parents considerable concern. One of the surest ways of detecting tuberculosis in its early stages, while there is yet a chance for cure, is to have a physical examination, including an X-ray picture by a competent physician each year.

Special care should be taken if it is known that the young woman has been in close contact with an open case of tuberculosis. Statistics show that most new cases of the disease develop after direct contact with an old case.
