Clayton Smith Head of Forest Preserve Board

A forest preserve district almost a decade in advance of its original improvement project is what Emmett Whelan, president of the board of forest preserve commissioners, elected to membership of the board of tax appeals, will turn over to Clayton F. Smith, who will become president of the board of forest preserve commissioners next Monday.

This was achieved by the observance of strict economy, plus assistance given by the CWA, Emergency Relief and CCC, and the intelligent distribution of these organizations throughout the 33,000 acres comprising the forest preserve by Charles G. Sauer, general superintendent of the forest preserve district, to translate draftsmen's blue prints into new bridges, trail shelter houses, picnic shelter houses, warming shelters and construction of various forms, it was reported.

Improvement is shown on all sides as one drives through the district. The 175 miles of bridle and hiking trails are greatly improved. Sixty-six trail shelter houses each containing fire places, a half dozen picnic shelter houses, warming shelters at the popular winter sports areas—Palos Hills and Dan Ryan Woods, planting of hundreds of thousands of trees and shrubs, cleaning of 75 miles of streams traversing the forest preserve, and a major improvement project at Skokie valley where ten companies of CCC are transforming an erstwhile marsh into a series of lagoons and beautiful landscape.

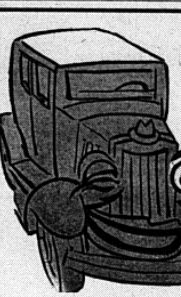
