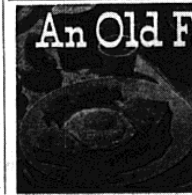
The village of Libertyville under the recent decision of the state supreme court has a claim of \$299.41 against the state of Illinois for taxes paid, through the utilities sales tax act.
