

Report on Condition of First State Bank

A quarterly statement showing the financial condition of the closed First State Bank of Barrington was released in the state auditor's report issued by Edward J. Barrett, state auditor, last week. The local closed institution was one of six banks to make repayments to depositors in the last quarter. The People's State Bank of Arlington Heights is expected to make a five per cent repayment within the year.

Complete analysis of the individual report of the First State Bank of Barrington, with an estimate of probable future repayments, follows:

First State Bank of Barrington—Total receipts, \$443,125; paid prior claims, \$120,755; paid \$38,433 RFC loan in full; paid depositors, \$154,866, or 55 per cent. Costs: receivers, \$1,987; legal, \$13,041; clerical, \$26,848; interest, \$1,805; advanced to protect assets, \$67,661; with \$54,933 refunded. Cash, \$5,952. Total repayment percentages at a rate reported to range from 75 to 80 per cent, ultimately.
