The law requires that a turn shall not be made unless and until it can be made with safety and then only after giving an approp-riate signal in the event that any other vehicle may be affected by

the maneuver.

Signals must be given from the left side of the vehicle, continuously for the last fifty feet traveled before making the indicated movement.
