Christmas Mailing Delays Delivery of State Auto Plates

The heavy volume of Christmas mail is delaying the delivery of automobile plates, post office officials advised Secretary of State Edward J. Hughes Saturday.

It was stated by the Springfield postal officials that Christmas mailings already have reached such proportions that prompt delivery of plates could not be guaranteed.

"If you have applied for your plates and fail to receive them up to date," said Secretary Hughes, "do not become alarmed. There is no reason to fear that your application or plates have gone astray. While automobile licenses are very important and we are besought to get them out early to most folks, they are not as important at this particular season as the pack Santa is bringing into Illinois this year."

Secretary Hughes pointed out, however, that plates can be purchased without delay over the counter, either at the state house in Springfield or at the Chicago branch office at 120 South Ashland boulevard.
